EXO users: *NEW* SQL Reporting Services Reports

A set of Microsoft Reporting Services reports for Exo is now available from VIS. It has most of the standard reports that are supplied with Exo but bypasses the need to run under Clarity. You can access the reports from your internal Reporting portal (Reporting Services is a standard component of SQL Server Standard and Enterprise). Has the ability to schedule reports and email them on a scheduled basis.

The benefits are that you do not need an Exo licence to run reports; it runs on the server and so reduces the network traffic to the workstation, can be scheduled, can be exported to Excel and Word as well as PDF or viewed online.

Cost: \$1000+GST per site. Installation not included. Annual Support Fee of 15% covers the upgrading to latest version of Exo. Other reports can be written on a time and materials basis.

VI Assets Update

Version 1364 is now available; enhancements/fixes include:

- Fixed the location filter in the Position Statement report
- Enable editing of accumulated depreciation after asset revaluations
- Ability to merge multiple creditor invoices into one asset (Exo integrated)
- New report detailing the GL journals posted out of VIA (integrated)
- Ability to import assets with parent/child relationships (Pro)
